An Introduction to Cancer: Anatomy, Biology & Treatments

Introduction

This is a two day course by David O'Halloran which presents a basic understanding of cancer. Through a series of presentations, the speaker describes how cancer develops, the commonest types of cancer, cancer detection and treatment modalities. The sessions are supplemented by quizzes to aid understanding and group interactive question and answer sessions to keep everyone engaged.



Topics Covered

- Introduction to cells, tissues and cancer
- The spread of cancer
- Classification of cancer
- Overview of treatment options for cancer
- Colorectal cancer
- Leukaemia and lymphoma
- Lung cancer
- Breast and Prostate cancer

Intended audience

This two day course is specifically designed for staff new to oncology. Suitable for research, admin support, industry, CTU, hospice and any other staff groups who require an overview and understanding of the anatomy, biology and treatments of cancer. - How disease progression will influence patient management
- How tumours can be classified with specific consideration of staging and grading systems
- The role of radiotherapy, chemotherapy and targeted therapies in the treatment of cancer
